Award Categories include:

- OUTSTANDING CHAMBER VOLUNTEER** - This award is given to a Tualatin Chamber of Commerce volunteer who has been an integral part of the chamber by freely giving of their time and talents to make the chamber better, and whose efforts in chamber activities and projects was outstanding. They have demonstrated leadership skills, and have shown support for other chamber members.
- BUSINESS EXCELLENCE AWARD** - This award is given to a business who has demonstrated successful business practices, and who shows a demonstrated interest in the welfare of the Tualatin community through financial contributions, involvement and civic leadership. The business demonstrates excellence in management, promotes economic growth and has been recognized for excellence within their industry. The award is based on achievement not company size. Membership in the Tualatin Chamber of Commerce is not required.
- DISTINGUISHED CITIZEN AWARD** - The Distinguished Citizen Award reflects someone who made specific, significant, lasting contributions to the Tualatin community. Recipients must have demonstrated leadership and cooperation while benefiting community and/or civic enterprises in the Tualatin area. Membership in the Tualatin Chamber of Commerce is not necessary.
- SPIRIT OF TUALATIN AWARD** - This award is presented to an individual, group, club or business in recognition of their volunteer contributions to the community that have gone largely unheralded; whose dedication to community and civic projects has made Tualatin a better place to live; whose leadership and example has inspired others to exceed their own limitations and accomplish more than they thought possible.
- OUTSTANDING YOUNG PERSON AWARD** - A young person who has given unselfishly in religious, charitable, or community areas, and has demonstrated their commitment to the Tualatin community through civic activities and leadership.
- COMMITMENT TO YOUTH AWARD** - This award is given to someone who has shown through volunteering and involvement in the community a commitment to helping the youth in the Tualatin community. It can be someone who volunteers in the schools, or for non-profits; someone who has been shown to be a great mentor of children; or someone who is employed to help youth, but has gone above and beyond what is expected of them.
- OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD** - Nominated by service clubs, organizations and non-profits. This award is given to a service club or non-profit organization, or a member within. This person or organization has shown outstanding leadership, both within their organization and in their involvement in the Tualatin community.

NOTE: if a Celebrate Tualatin committee member has a personal relationship with any nominee, they will declare a conflict of interest and remove themselves from the discussion and voting of that category.
